may apply for travel and accommodation funding to make it possible for them to attend the 10th I3E 2010 conference. Young researchers are researchers at pre-doctoral level and up to an age limit of 35 years old at the time of the conference. A committee reviews their applications and awards grants to the students who would not otherwise have the resources to attend the conference.

Grants cover the students' registration fee, travel and lodging expenses up to the maximum of 500 Euros per grant. Registration fee is reduced to 187 Euros (240 USD), the remaining 313 Euro may be used for travel and lodging expenses. Students should note that the grant sizes are fixed, so that any costs in excess of the grant will not be reimbursed.

Applications for grants will be evaluated by the I3E steering committee. Grants will be awarded based on the evaluating committee's assessment of the student's genuine financial need, the potential benefit to the student's education, research, and career, and the potential benefit to the conference. The committee will favor students who are co-authors of accepted papers.

To apply for a grant, students should send an email to Prof. Wojciech Cellary (`cellary "at" kti.ue.poznan.pl`), I3E Program Co-Chair, explaining how they believe attending the conference will benefit them. The letter should quote the lowest available ticket or airfare from the student's location to the conference site, and the bank account details of the student's institution for reimbursement. The application should include an attachment from the student's graduate advisor describing the student's work and the benefit to that work of attending the conference.

Applications are due before September 10, 2010. The committee decisions will be made before September 30, 2010.

If the student does in fact attend the conference and present receipts, the conference organizer will reimburse the student's lodging expenses for the duration of the conference, and will reimburse the travel cost to the student's institution, without exceeding the total amount of the grant for all expenses.
